WARA owns a couple HF and 2 meter transceivers for field day use and is not for sale, however will make available to loan members if needed on a temporary basis. Please contact John, N1JAF for details.



GO BOX DON EKLUND, N1EDF



I built this box to make field day and camping trip well organized. This unit can run on 110 volt power from the grid or from my 200 watt Honda generator. It can also run on a 12 volt deep cycle battery if needed.

I mounted an SO 238 on the side of the box to receive my dual band 2M/70CM antenna for the Kenwood TM-D710.

For HF I use a 100 ft. end fed dipole 80-6 portable HF antenna Matchbox system or the Alpha antenna multibank 6-80 tuner free portable antenna.



The parts and equipment list I built it with are as follows.

- Icom IC-7000 HF/2M/70CM
- Kenwood TM-D710 2M/70CM with BLuelight for APRS
- Alinco DM-330FXT 30A power supply with USB ports

- Super PWRgate PG40S
- Tigertronics Signalink USB for digital mode operation
- LDG AT-100Proll Antenna Tuner


